

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Provisional Bookings: If the deposit is not received within 14 days of a provisional booking being made, the hotel may release the booking without notice. Deposits are not transferable to beverage. Please note that due to the large number of payments made for the festive season, the hotel will not accept individual payments from your party, all payments must be made by the main booking contact.

Accommodation: All bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis. A rooming list for the rooms will be required with the final balance payment. Prices quoted are based on standard rooms. Deluxe rooms and suites incur supplement prices.

Deposits: A non-refundable deposit of £50.00 per person is required to secure Christmas and New Year residential packages. A non-refundable £10.00 per person deposit is required for an event or accommodation. All non-residential events are subject to a non-refundable deposit of £10.00 per person. Please make all cheques payable to New Lanark Hotels Ltd.

Final Payment, Numbers & Pre-Orders:

This will be required no later than the 30th October 2018. Any balance of payments not received by this date may mean that your booking is released without notice. All payments made on or after this date are non-refundable. Pre-orders for Christmas Party nights and Christmas Day Lunch are also required. If a pre-order is not received the hotel has the right to serve a set menu to the party. Please note the hotel does not send out reminders or invoices for payment or pre-orders.

Cancellations: As stated above the deposits and final payments once paid are strictly non-refundable with NO exceptions, all requests for refunds will be declined. Cancellations due to weather conditions, which are out of our control, are also non-refundable.

Bar/Company Accounts: We will not set up any bar or company accounts unless they have been authorised prior to the event and designated signatories agreed.

Minimum Numbers: Should there be insufficient numbers booked for any event we reserve the right to offer alternative dates or to cancel an event with a full refund.

Table Sizes/Location: Due to capacities at public events you may be occupying a table with other guests. The location of your table will be known on the day; requests to be in a particular area can be made but are not guaranteed.

Special Requests: Any special requests regarding accommodation or special dietary requirements must be given to the hotel in writing. Please advise if any of your party is a wheelchair user or has a disability.

Group Organiser (Party Nights): To ensure prompt service for all groups, keeping to the times stated in your final balance letter is essential. The group organiser will be the hotel's main contact, should any monies be outstanding, we will contact the organiser in the first instance.

General: Please note events and accommodation are subject to availability. The Management has the right to eject any guests attending any function from the hotel for disruptive behaviour and we will not tolerate violence in any form, including the use of foul and abusive language, towards New Lanark Mill Hotel employees. Any guest who damages any hotel property will be held responsible for charges for either repair or replacement of the item/s. May we remind you that in accordance with Scottish legislation our function room and all public areas are non-smoking areas.
