New Lanark was founded in 1785 by Scottish Entrepreneur David Dale as a cotton spinning village and became famous as the site of Robert Owen's radical reforms. Many ideas expressed by Robert Owen (1771-1858) remain amazingly relevant. The international cultural influence of his campaign for a better and fairer society is one of the reasons New Lanark was inscribed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 2001.
